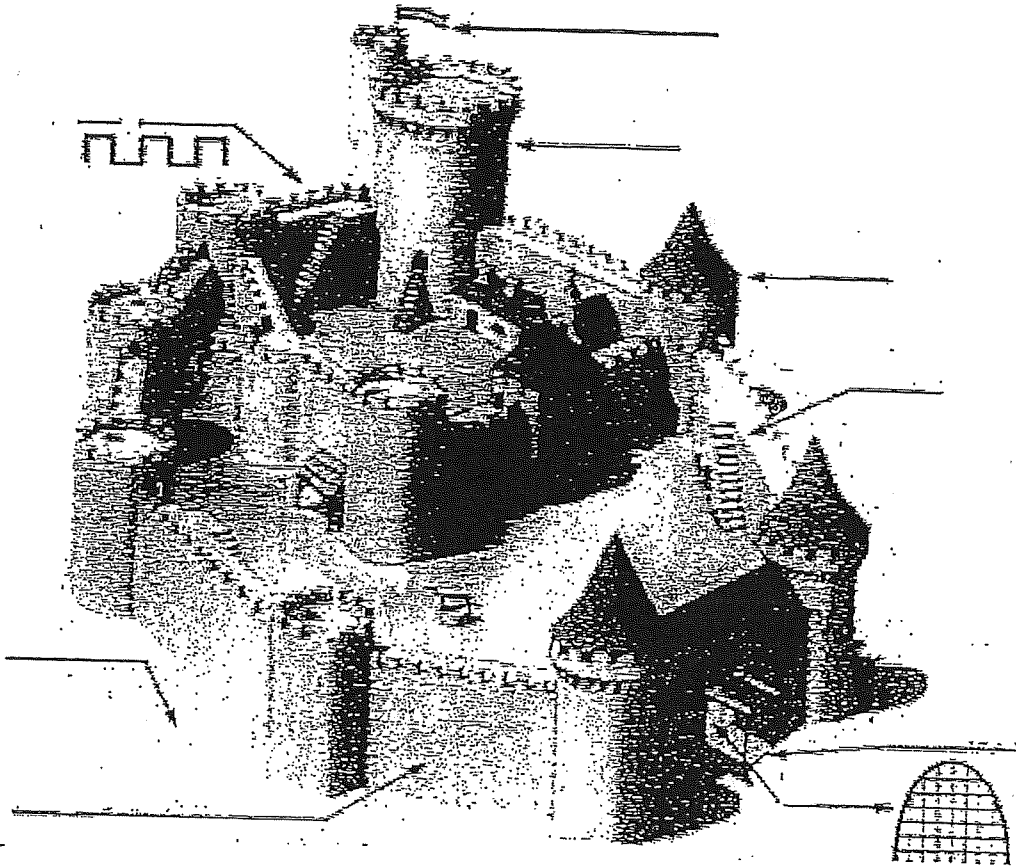


The Castle-Fortress

The _____ of the Middle Ages were designed to protect their occupants.

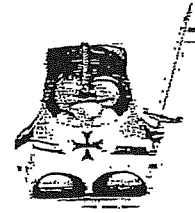
The _____ were tiny openings that allowed to aim or monitor opponents while being protected.
