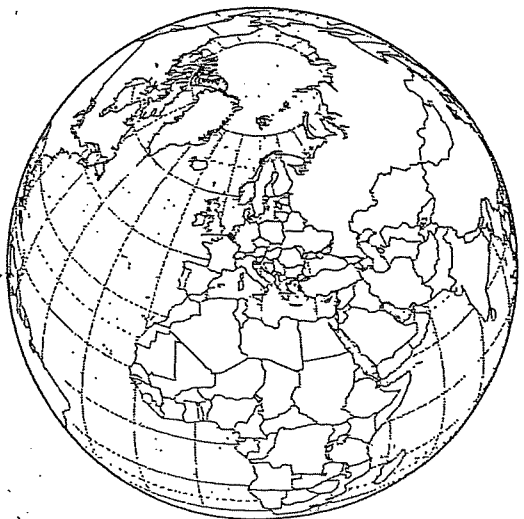

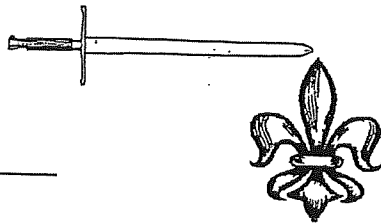

## The King

The king was the most important figure during the Middle Ages. He was at the top of the feudal system. This is how this system worked: the peasants paid their taxes to the lords and the lords then gave them to the kings. The lord served the king. He also gave him advice to help him with decisions. In return, the king gave them castles (also called fiefs) and wealth.

Usually, when the king spoke, people listened. Those who did not obey the king were often sentenced to death. The king always led his army in battles and wars. He had to show everyone that he could give them the final victory. The king thought that all his subjects should believe in God. He had to set an example on this point. The king was present at every important event. His presence was necessary because it was important for him to continue to be king. It was also important for him to show himself in the presence of the Queen.
